- Dinner at Noon: Prepare/serve lunch on Saturday morning at the Carver Center
- Men's Clothing Closet: Donate; help organize and distribute clothing
- Thrift Shop: Donate; volunteer to organize shop and help run sales
- Coming Home: Cook/ serve meal; help with transportation to train station
- Coming Home Mentor: Be paired with formerly incarcerated and mentor them
- Prison Ministry: Monthly meetings with inmates at Sing Sing or Fishkill CF
- Helping Hands: Help make sandwiches on a Thursday morning
